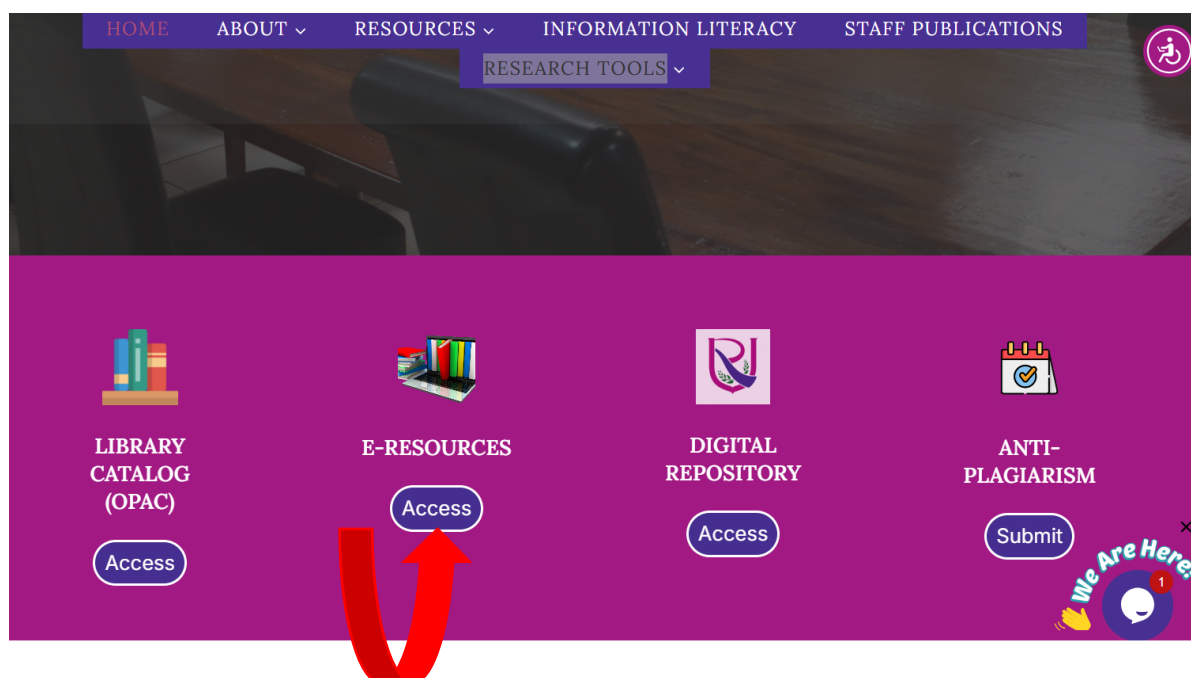
Brief Guide on How to Access Electronic Resources

Riara University subscribes to a number of worldwide electronic databases, which give access to thousands of scholarly electronic journals and electronic books.

To get access to these resources, follow the guidelines below:

Step 1: Go to your browser and type library.riarauniversity.ac.ke

This will take you Riara university library website

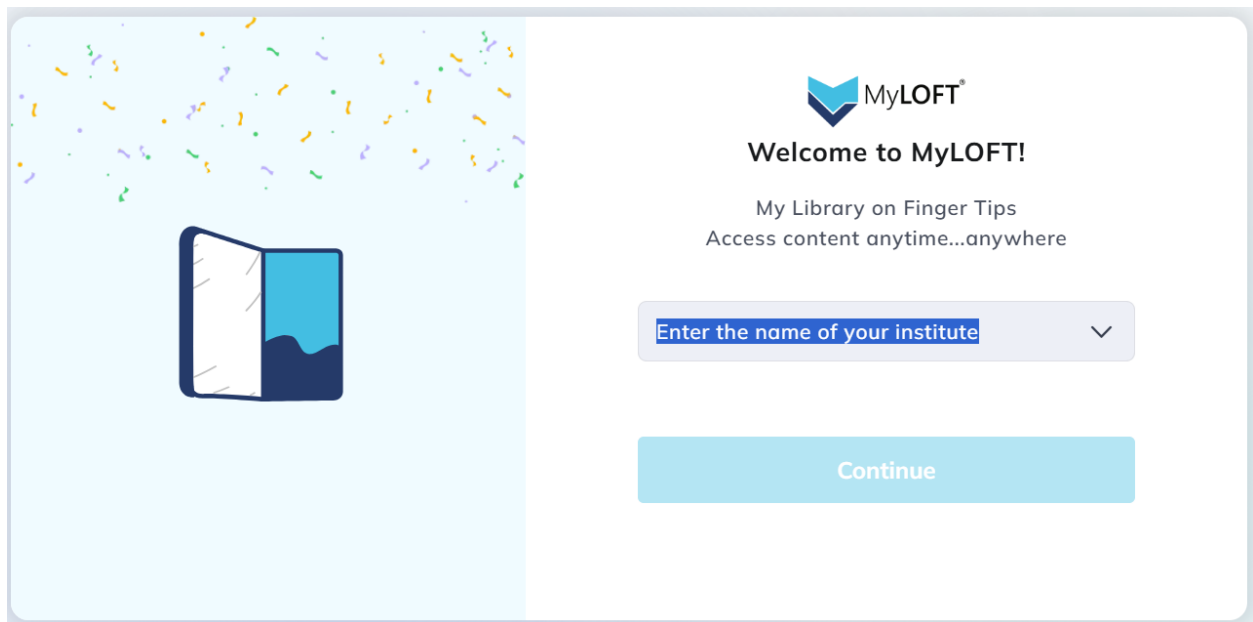


Step 2: Click on E-Resources

This will take you to the MyLOFT **sign in /sign up** page

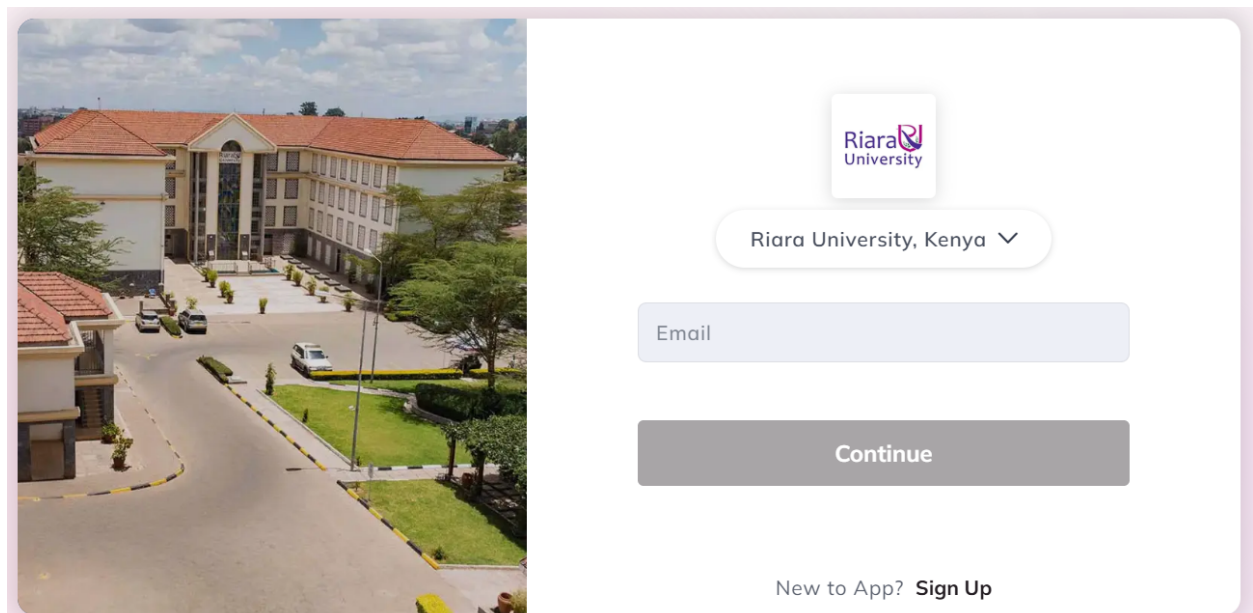
MyLOFT stands for “*My Library On Fingertips*,”. **MyLOFT** is a web and mobile application designed for seamless access to your library subscribed e-resources.

Step 3: Enter Riara University, click continue



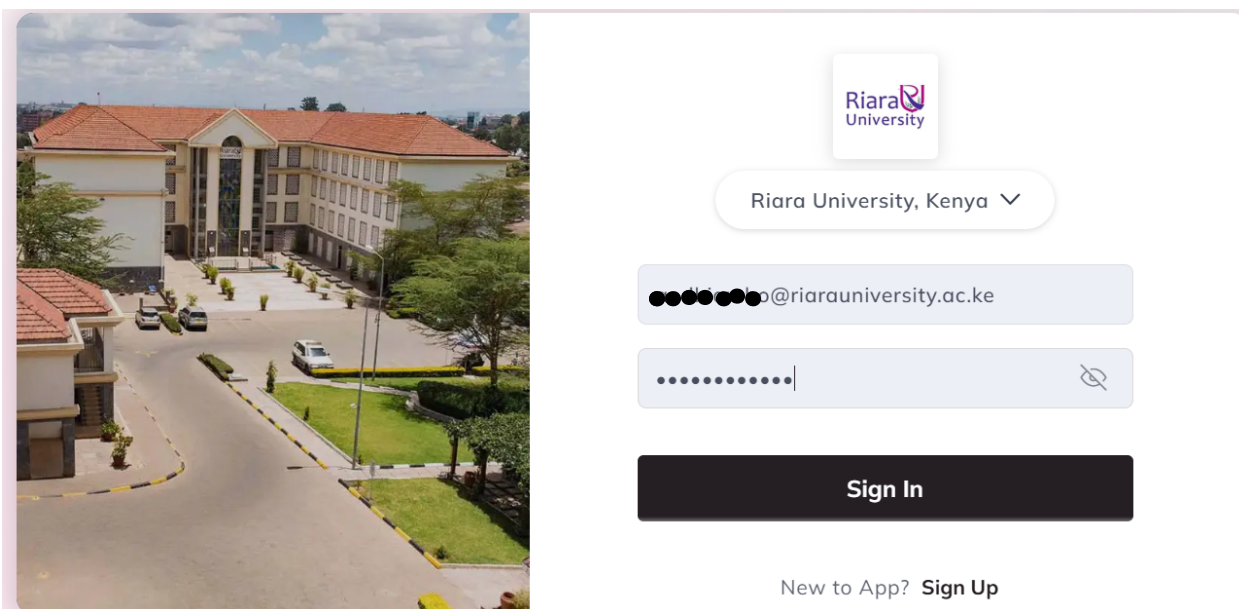

Step 4: Click on **sign up** and fill in details if no account, if with account type in your Riara University email address and **click continue**

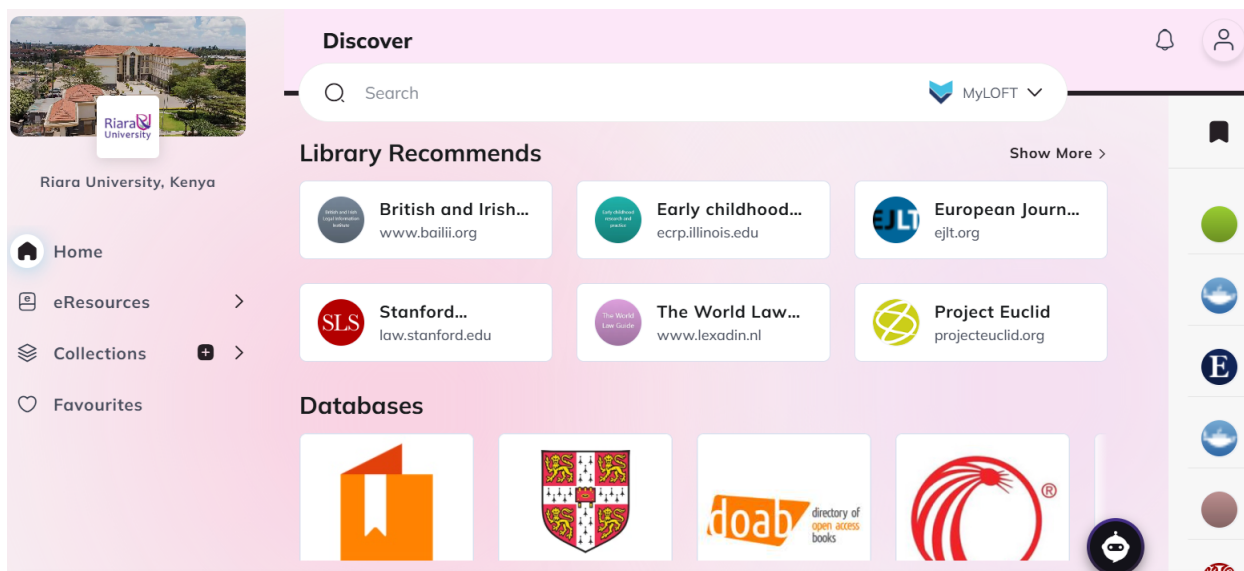
